

## Dear Parents

Welcome back to what is a very different Term 2. We have started the term with approximately two-thirds of our students attending school for face-to-face teaching whilst one-third remain at home to participate in distance learning through a variety of modes. I would sincerely like to thank our community for all your prompt responses to surveys and following directives to allow us to manage the return to school as per the guidelines set out by AHPPC and the State Government.

It is important to note that we are not able to run assemblies, incursions or excursions and interschool activities until there is further easing of restrictions. Therefore I will not be sending home a Term 2 planner at this stage until we can resume extra-curricular activities. Once restrictions ease we will review our Term Planners with adjustments being made in line with allowed activities. Not all events and activities that have been cancelled since late Term 1 will be rescheduled. We will review and prioritise our planning so as not to overload Term 3 and 4.

## Distance Learning

Children learning at home will need to return work to teachers so that work can be marked, feedback given and future learning planned, based on achievement. Each team will do this slightly differently so please read the instructions in teacher emails, Connect and Seesaw. Most classes have provided an option to submit by email or by returning hard copies of work.

Each Monday until school resumes for all, all hard copy work completed at home should be placed back into the zip lock bag provided, labelled with your child's name and dropped into the returns box at the front of the school. If you have opted for a printed work package you will also need to collect a new package, labelled with your child's name from a box at the front of the school at the same time.

The State Government will make further decisions regarding schooling during Week 3 of this term for commencement in Week 4. After this announcement I will update you accordingly in preparation for any changes from Week 4 onwards.

## ANZAC Day

With the current restrictions in place ANZAC Day was without the usual ceremonies and marches although many of you would have participated in driveway vigils at dawn on ANZAC Day. It was heartening to see the community coming together in such a way to ensure ANZAC Day did not go without commemoration.

During Week 10 we had a small number of children of essential workers attending school for supervision. These children worked with our fantastic Education Assistants to make a wreath, discuss the history of the ANZACs and held a 1 - minute silence by our flagpoles.

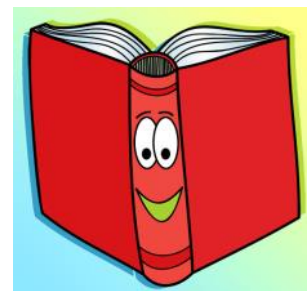
